Dear Sir/Madam,

On 19 July 2010 the United Nations Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC) tasked its Commission on Science and Technology for Development (CSTD) to establish a working group to **propose improvements to the Internet Governance Forum**.

In particular, the CSTD was asked to:

- establish a working group in an open and inclusive manner, to seek compile and review inputs from all UN member States and all other stakeholders on the improvement of the Internet Governance Forum (IGF) in line with its mandate as set out in the Tunis Agenda for the Information Society;
- report to the next substantive session of the ECOSOC session in 2011 with recommendations as appropriate.

According to its mandate, the Working Group will have to report to the next CSTD in May 2011. At the same time, the General Assembly is expected to take a decision on the continuation of the IGF by December 2010. Should the mandate of the IGF be extended, this report is to constitute an input from the Commission to the General Assembly, through ECOSOC.<sup>1</sup>

The Hon. Sherry Ayittey, Minister of Environment, Science and Technology of Ghana, the current Chair of the CSTD, delegated the task of establishing the CSTD Working Group on IGF to Mr. Frederic Riehl, vice Chair of the CSTD.

In accordance with the Working Group's mandate, the Chair of the Working Group is seeking input from all stakeholders. The principal issues in this consultation are set out in the questionnaire which can be found in Appendix 1 to this letter. 
